### **IT'S COMFORTABLE HERE**

After their deliverance from Egypt through the parting of the Red Sea, the people of Israel wandered in the wilderness for forty years. During this time, almost all of the people over twenty (when they crossed the Red Sea) died. A new generation of Jews has grown up to take their place. They were led by Joshua, who was a man of great faith. Joshua would lead most of the people of Israel into the land of promise. Shortly before they came to the banks of the Jordan river, God had given Israel great victories over two very powerful enemies. These were enemies who are on the east side of the Jordan river. This east side of the Jordan river, was not part of the land promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. In Joshua 12, we read about Israel defeating Og, the king of Bashan, and Sihon, king of the Amorites.

What is significant about this scene is that 2 1/2 of the tribes of Israel requested to stay outside of the land of promise in the land of Og and Sihon. Ruben, Gad and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the tribe of Manasseh. Moses granted their request.

We are not told explicitly why they stayed on the east side of the Jordan river, outside of the land of promise. I think they were driven by comfort and fear. The land has already been subdued. It is good land, at least comparing it to the desert they've lived in the last 40 years. They were worried that conquering the land on the West side of the Jordan would be very difficult. Though we can note that they did pledge to send armies to help the rest of Israel conquer the land. That promise was really not fulfilled. They sent a pittance of their army, while most of the soldiers stayed home.

For these 2 1/2 tribes, I think they were more concerned with their comfort than they were with following the Lord in the path that He was opening up before them. I think this is a really easy thing to do. When we think about change, especially when we're older, we get tired. New challenges are for the young. Conquering new territory is what we did when we were younger. It's hard to think about starting into those kind of struggles again. Sometimes, we'd rather just stay where we are. We'd rather just have things stay the same.

The decision that these  $2 \ 1/2$  tribes made ended up being catastrophic for them. They were always separate from the rest of the people of God. There was much misunderstanding and mistrust grew between the two and a half tribes and the rest of the tribes of Israel. They had a very difficult time in

maintaining their relationship with the Lord because they were
