NOW WHAT?

After hearing the results of the merger vote, I felt a little overwhelmed with emotion. Even now, I am not sure what I was feeling then or now. I texted the results to Pastor Miles. He texted me back, "Wow! Now what?" That is a great summary of how I feel.

Obviously, the merger will not be official until the building loan is gone. We have decided to do a 'soft launch' starting March 23, 2025.

Here are some of the key features of the soft launch:

- Both churches will worship together at Trinity
- Pastor Miles will do most of the preaching
- Jona Gallegos will lead the worship services integrating the worship teams
- · Finances will be kept independent Trinity people give to Trinity; Redemption people will give to Redemption (Redeeming Grace will not exist as a name until the formal and legal merger)
- · Most other ministries will continue the normal schedule but invitations to those ministries will be extended to both churches (e.g. Bible studies, Sunday School, AWANA, VBS, Believer's Fellowship, etc.)
- · Pastor Miles will start keeping office hours at Trinity
- We will likely have a 'ministry fair' where you will have opportunity to see all of the ministries that will be running with the combined churches and all of the opportunities that you have to serve
- · Some equipment and systems will be brought in from Redemption (kids check-in, sound equipment, etc.)

This is a profound and new chapter in the history of Trinity Baptist Church. It is my prayer that all members of Trinity will walk forward with us into this new chapter.

MEOW GROUPS



March Game Night March 21st Everyone's welcome!! Dear brothers and sisters of Trinity Baptist Church,

Upon learning about the final votes for merge from both our churches (TBC - 83% and RCS - 97%) I texted Pastor Blaine these words, "Praise the Lord! Now what?" The words came from an overwhelming sense of awe in what the Lord has done in both our church families, a great sense of joy and hope for our future together, but also a keen awareness of what this means, especially for you dear saints at Trinity.

As I write this, I am sitting in your conference room working on sermon prep for Redemption this Sunday. I have prayed and thought of you often over the course of these nearly two weeks. And while there is much over which to rejoice, I know full well that there are apprehensions—there usually are when people set out for a new adventure. There will be challenges along the way; there will be new people, lots of kids, and changes (some welcomed and some maybe not so much). However, it is my deep desire that along the way in our soft transition towards a merged church (Redeeming Grace) that the Lord will draw us closer to Him and knit our hearts more sweetly toward one another so that we may be about kingdom work "better together."

I also want you to know that your brothers and sisters at Redemption are excited for what the Lord is doing, but they share some of the same nervousness that you may have. They will be leaving the place that for 10 years has been their "home." And while that history is quite short in comparison to the 70-year history of Trinity, in those 10 years, for many, they came to faith in Christ and were baptized; they were married, welcomed their first child (and for some a lot more that would follow); and some have tragically lost a spouse or a child. All of which Trinity has experienced and will continue to experience in this location. But for Redemption, though our church "home" has been filled with such joys and sorrows, blessings and hardship, it is hard to leave a place filled with such powerful memories. Nevertheless, among your brothers and sisters at Redemption, there is a greater desire to enter into this new adventure because we too believe it is of God.

Personally and pastorally, I have been the recipient of much blessing and joy throughout this merger exploration process. Chief among them is my relationship with Pastor Blaine. I didn't truly know how much I needed such a collegial and personal friendship (outside of Redemption) until the Lord placed Pastor Blaine in my life. I have grown to respect, admire, and love your pastor. The times we have spent together, I believe, have helped us both grow as brothers and pastors in our two churches. Now as the Lord has seen fit to allow for our working together to care for those whom the Lord has placed under our pastoral care, I am refreshed and comforted. For much of my 27 years of pastoral ministry, I too was a solo pastor, and while there were wonderful experiences of fruitfulness, as well as challenges, serving alone is hard. Already, today, Pastor Blaine and I have visited randomly about a few things—because we were next door to one another. I love that.

Dear brothers and sisters, I look forward to what the Lord has for all of us—that He who began a good work in Trinity 70 years ago and in Redemption over 10 years ago, will bring the work He has set before us to completion, as we long for day of Christ Jesus (cf. Philippians 1:6).
